



CONTINUITY - SCRIPT SUPERVISOR DEPARTMENT QUALIFICATIONS

Thank you for your interest in the Script Supervisor Department of IATSE Local 856. Please take a few moments to read the following and assess your qualifications before filling out an application.

MUST POSSESS THE FOLLOWING – Please provide photocopies to verify your:

- Successful completion of a certified Script Supervisor Course or other recognized Script Supervisor training course.
- Proof of attendance at a Set Etiquette Course
- Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- Successful completion of Grade 12 English.
- 6 months of employment and/or working volunteer experience on a film set in any department (not observing).

ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING – Please provide photocopies to verify:

- 12 months of employment with a professional Theatre or Film Production Company.
- 18 months of employment (or continuous volunteer experience) with a community broadcaster.
- 12 months of employment (or experience) in Editing.
- Demonstrated interest (for example, with writing, producing, directing your own films).
- Two years of post secondary education in a Film or Theatre Craft school, recognized by the Manitoba Ministry of Education or its counterpart in other provinces, states, or countries.
- Two years of post secondary education in a school of Broadcast Communications specializing in Television or Film, recognized by the Manitoba Ministry of Education or its counterpart in other provinces, states, or countries.

STRONGLY RECOMMEND THE FOLLOWING – Please provide photocopies to verify:

- Computer knowledge
- Shorthand or speed writing

Membership Status

Membership applications will be considered for individuals who have worked 60+ days on 2 or more IATSE 856 films in this position. Two letters of reference are required from the following positions: Editor, Assistant Editor, Director or a Producer.

All member applicants must also show proof of a current basic first aid

Be sure to clearly indicate which of the above qualifications you possess. Provide detailed information about your previous experience (list job duties, Supervisors, exact days worked, etc.). Incomplete information will not be considered.

Should you submit an application with incomplete information or without possessing the qualifications shown, please be aware that the processing fee is non-refundable. Applications can take up to six months to process. You will be notified as soon as your application has been reviewed. Please do not telephone and inquire about the status of your application.
