- A valid Safe Food Handling Course Level 1
- Set Etiquette course (Film Training Manitoba, 989-9669)
- Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training

Each application must include:

- A completed Permittee Application form (specify which category you are applying for)
- This sheet with your qualifications checked off
- A resume (specify dates, number of days worked, job duties, supervisors)
- Photocopies of all documents/educational certificates listed on the reverse
- Photocopies of both sides of your Intermediate First Aid Certificate
- \$50 processing fee

If you are accepted for work as a Permittee, it is your responsibility to keep your First Aid Certificate and resume up to date as well as your correct address and phone number on file in the form of an updated resume. Any person without current information on file will be removed from the roster.
