- Possess basic landscaping experience.
- Have good knowledge of common plant & tree species.
- Possess a valid Manitoba driver's license (you may require business class insurance).
- Have the ability to operate landscape and power tools
- Possess a valid Occupational First Aid Ticket, Level 1 or higher (please include a copy).
- Set Etiquette course (Film Training Manitoba, phone 989-9669).
- Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training

Job duties include heavy lifting, working in the inclement weather, often on difficult terrain. Applicants must possess the physical ability and agility to complete the required job tasks.

Please do not telephone and inquire about your application status. Should you submit an application with incomplete information or without possessing the qualifications shown, please be aware that the processing fee is non-refundable.

- 1 60 Days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE 856 Films in the department (in the position applying for)
- 2 Letters of reference from 2 I.A.T.S.E. Keys (1 from Greens & 1 from related department)
- 3 Set Etiquette course
- 4 Valid Class 5 Drivers License
- 5 Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- 6 Basic First Aid

Department Transfer – Applicants for Department Transfer must demonstrate the following:

- 1 Set Etiquette course.
- 2 Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- 3 Valid Class 5 Drivers License
- 4 60 Days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Films in the position being applied for

Members Upgrading – Members wishing to upgrade their classifications must demonstrate the following:

- 1 60 Days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Films in the position being applied for
- 2 Letters of reference from 2 I.A.T.S.E. Keys (1 from Greens & 1 from related department)
