Thank you for your interest in the Make Up department of I.A.T.S.E. Local 856. Please take a few moments to read the following before filling out an application.

To apply for Permittee Status, an applicant must supply proof of the following:

(Please check off the qualifications & tools you possess and include this form with your application.)

- Diploma from a recognized Make Up school (minimum curriculum must include: Corrective and Glamour makeup, Age with paint, Age with latex, Human hair beard application/grooming & ventilated pieces, Bald caps, Special Effects, Make Up for Film and Television, Make Up for B & W Film and Photography), or a 300 word summary and portfolio detailing self directed study.
- Proof of **Set Etiquette Course** (Contact Film Training Manitoba at 989-9669 for details)
- Proof of Current **WHMIS** Instruction/Training (Contact Film Training Manitoba at 989-9669 for details)
- Possess a kit meeting the minimum requirements (see over for list)

Each application must include:

- A completed application form
- This sheet with your qualifications and equipment checked off
- A resume (specify exact dates, number of days worked, job duties, supervisors)
- Photocopies of all educational certificates & licenses listed
- \$50.00 processing fee

Persons possessing the necessary qualifications will be invited to take an evaluation test.

Be sure to clearly indicate how you satisfy the above qualifications. You may be required to supply cheque stubs, time sheets etc., as proof of hours worked. Incomplete information will not be accepted.

Should you submit an application with incomplete information or without possessing the qualifications shown, please be aware that the processing fee is non-refundable.

Applications can take up to six months to process. You will be notified as soon as your application has been reviewed. Please do not telephone and inquire as to the status of your application.

Should you be accepted for work as a Permittee in the Make Up department, you may be required to participate in a training program with partial wages/reduced hours.

To qualify for membership all applicants must have basic first aid

FOUNDATIONS

A good selection of shades for any skin tone. It is recommended to use established professional brands such as William Tuttle, R.C.M.A., Visiora, Kroylan, Joe Blasco or Ben Nye.

LINER COLOURS

- Basic colour wheel colors. It is recommended to include SPFX colours such as the BLASCO Death Colours and the Ben Nye bruise or burn colours.

CHEEK COLOURS

- A good assortment of colours in cake or moist form. Try to have colours to compliment any skin undertone.

LIP COLOURS

- Try to have colours to compliment any possible skin colour/undertone. Some matte, some frost and some specialty colours for period work. A good kit should also contain a selection of lipgloss colours and a good range of lip pencils.

EYESHADOWS

- Try to have a range of colours to suit any possible subject. Products should be both matte and pearlized and include dry cake, water applied and crème colours. Eyeliners – (pencil or cake) neutral colours & fashion shades.

MASCARA/FALSE LASHES

- Black and brown mascara in waterproof and water-soluble. Cake mascara is optional. Disposable wands are a good idea. Both strip and individual false lashes, in brown and black. Eyelash adhesive (or Duo Surgical Adhesive).

NAIL POLISH

- Clear.

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Bald caps, two electric razors, colour process blood in various shades, prosthetic foundations (R.M.G.P.), tooth enamel (black and nicotine), FX bloods.
